Spotlight communications manager Eva Daly said vouchers had already been redeemed in the Bunbury store and they were looking forward to seeing the entries.

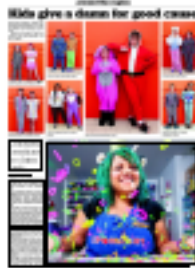
"We know how much Australian children have loved and embraced Rainbow Looms and we also know how great art and craft is for their
